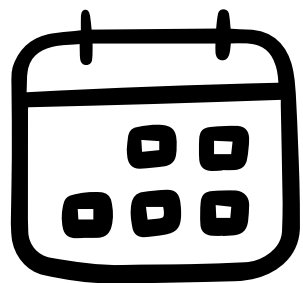
With SimchaSpace, your room schedule is solid. No one books a space without you knowing. Every recurring event is already in place. And when someone asks what's available? You answer instantly.

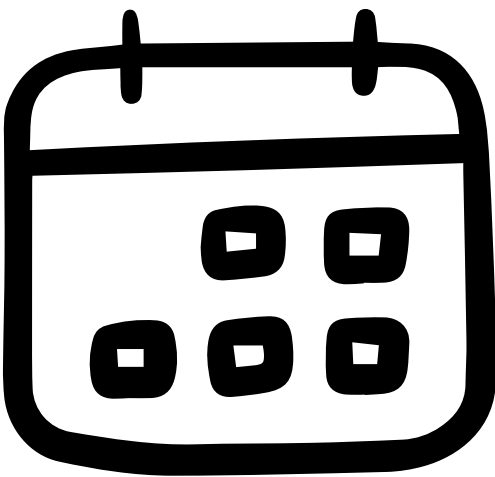

Easily flag unfamiliar names and share the list with your security team in a click.

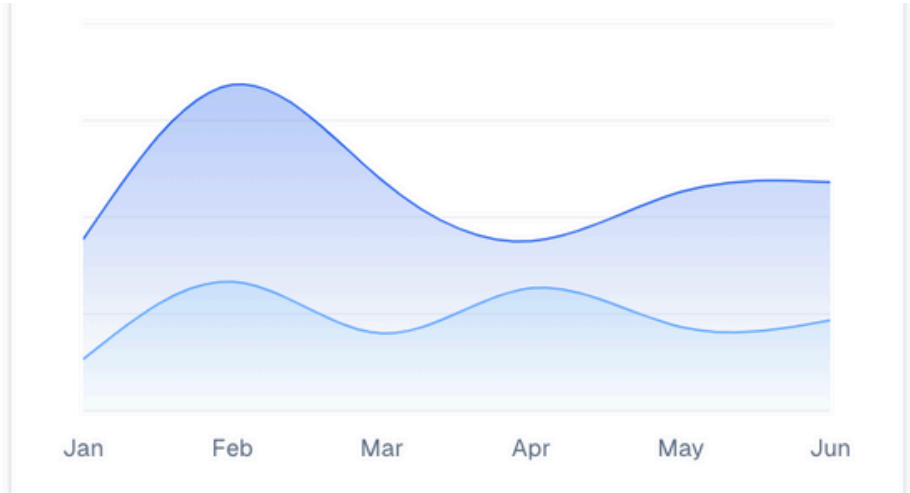

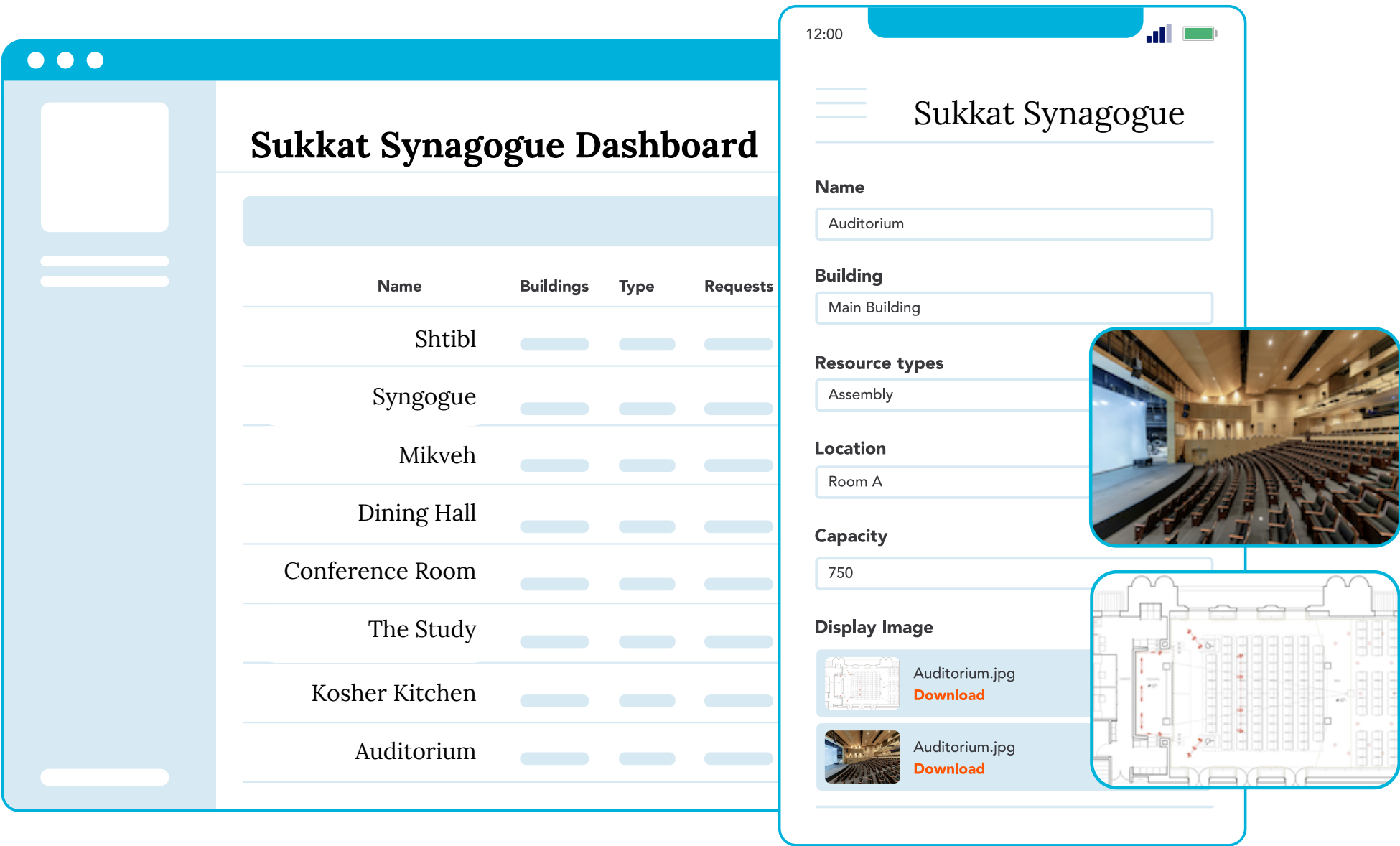

Dear Jennifer,

As the anniversary of your beloved, Scott West approaches, we extend our heartfelt thoughts and prayers to you and your family. This solemn time of remembrance offers an opportunity to honor the memory of your loved one and reflect on the lasting impact they have had on your life and our community.

According to our records, Scott departed on 17th Nisan 5783 that falls on April 15th, 2025 of this year. It is a tradition to light a Yahrzeit candle on the evening preceding the anniversary and recite Kaddish in their honor.

Lighting the Yahrzeit Candle: The Yahrzeit candle should be lit at sunset on the evening before the Yahrzeit date and should burn for 24 hours. Light your candles 18 minutes before sunset on April 14th, 2025. 18 minutes before sunset on this day, will be 07:32 PM. It is customary to recite prayers and reflect on the cherished memories shared with your loved one.

Synagogue Services: We warmly invite you to attend services at Adat Jisrael during this time of remembrance. Our regular service schedule is as follows:

- **Weekday Services:** Monday - Friday, 8:30 am - 9:30 am
- **Shabbat Services:** Friday 5:30 pm and Saturday 9:15 am

If you would like a Kaddish recited on behalf of your loved one during our synagogue services, please let us know. Additionally, if you would like to sponsor a Kiddush or make a donation in their memory, we would be honored to assist you in doing so.

May the memory of Scott West be a blessing, and may you find comfort in the cherished moments and values they imparted.
